

The Ultimate Canadian Wilderness Readiness Checklist

Phase 1: Digital Synchronization (The "No Signal" Prep)

- **GPX/KML Import:** All coordinates from this guide are synced into Gaia GPS/AllTrails+.
- **Offline Maps:** Topographical layers for specific park sectors are downloaded (1:24,000 scale).
- **Smartwatch Sync:** Waypoints uploaded to Garmin/Apple Watch for haptic navigation.
- **AQI App Check:** FireSmart Canada or BreezoMeter installed for real-time smoke tracking.

Phase 2: Logistical Compliance (The "Paperwork" Prep)

- **PCRS Confirmation:** Backcountry/Campsite permits printed or saved as offline PDFs.
- **Discovery Pass:** Physical pass hanging on the rearview mirror or digital QR code saved.
- **Indigenous Land Protocol:** Traditional territory identified via Native-Land.ca.
- **Emergency Contact:** Detailed trip itinerary left with a trusted person (non-hiker).

Phase 3: Safety & Critical Gear (The "Survival" Prep)

- **Satellite SOS:** Garmin InReach/Zoleo battery at 100% and subscription active.
- **Bear Safety:** Bear spray is in a hip holster (not in the pack) and within expiry date.
- **Food Storage:** Hard-sided bear canister (if mandated by specific park coordinates).
- **Analog Backup:** Magnetic compass and waterproof physical map of the sector.
